We build compost loos. Compost loos are an affordable environmentally friendly and easier alternative to an outside loo for your garden, campsite, allotment or any outside space where there are no mains sewers or mains water supply and we build them to order for you.

We run a smallholding in Wales and have built our own loos for the garden and for our guests that come and stay on our camp site and they work. We were asked to build one for one of our guests, they wanted one for their garden, saving the need for plumbing into the mains sewers and avoiding the risk of freezing up in the winter months. So we decided to market our loos and here we are.

The smallest size of the cubicle is 900mm wide x 1200mm deep x 2150mm at its highest point with a monopitch roof. All the necessary facts are on our 'faqs page'. If this doesn't answer your questions please call us on the telephone number below to discuss your requirements.

The faqs:

These compost loos are known as 'urine separating composting toilets'. So everyone sits down to use them, boys and girls unless you have opted for the separate mens urinal. This enables the separation of liquid waste from solid waste. This stops all the nasty smells associated with compost loos and they really do work. Its a simple design. Under the seat is a large container, into which you sprinkle a large scoop of sawdust, then its ready to use. When the container is full, you simple remove the lid of the loo, lift out the container and replace with a new one. The full container is then put in a corner somewhere to allow it to decompose. After a certain length of time(see our questions page) the compost as it now is can be used on your garden.

You have two choices to dispose of the urine. You can either build a soakaway next to where the compost loo is going to be sited or you can have the outlet pipe going into a container. This way you can then water the contents down - 8 parts water to 1 part urine - and use it on your compost heap to help speed up the decomposition of your ordinary garden waste. It also acts as a general fertiliser at the 8.1 ratio.

Our loos come complete, delivered to you on a pallet, ready to unload and use. Please note the picture below shows the disabled size loo with additional urinal.



They have as standard:

- Timber cubicle made from quality FSC redwood tongue and groove timber, treated with a preservative to the exterior.
- The urine separating loo seat with lid built into a timber framed box complete with container for solid waste and one spare container with sealable lid.
- The pipework already installed for the liquid waste and collection container.
- Vinyl flooring.
- Laminated instruction sheet.
- A battery operated LED light.
- A sliding bolt lock.
- A sawdust bin and scoop.
- And even a loo roll holder.

Your questions answered:-

Q. Is the timber used in the manufacture of the cubicles from a sustainable source?

A. Yes, 98% of the timber used is FSC accredited.

Q. What is a compost toilet?

A. A compost toilet is a dry or waterless toilet, i.e. one that doesn't use water to take the waste somewhere else; it also allows natural processes to produce natural compost, after a resting period.

Q. Do they smell.

A. No, they don't smell. After each use, just drop a handful of 'soak' (wood shavings or sawdust) into the toilet. This is because bacteria like to eat a balanced diet of carbon and nitrogen, and as human waste contains a lot of nitrogen, if they don't get enough carboniferous material (like sawdust, straw or shredded paper) they will give off excess nitrogen in the form of ammonia, which makes the loo smelly. Also the sawdust allows oxygen into the pile, and absorbs liquids. This allows the pile to decompose aerobically to produce nitrates, phosphates and sulphates. Without the sawdust the pile will decompose anaerobically and produce methane, ammonia and hydrogen sulphide - all very smelly and not very useful.

Human pathogens don't like conditions outside the human body, so almost all will be dead after a few hours. Only one type of roundworm egg can survive a year-long decomposition period, but even though it is a tiny risk, it is recommended using the compost on fruit trees and bushes, not on the vegetable garden.

Q. How long does it take for the solids to compost down?

A. It can take anything up to a year. It is necessary for the solids to be left for as long as possible before you start using it on your garden. . It needs air to help it decompose, so just leave it in the corner of your garden with the lid slightly loose and before you know it you have great compost for your plants.

Q. What are the benefits?

- the solid waste is dealt with on site, and doesn't have to be treated with chemicals in sewage farms, or end up in waterways;
- saves water - you don't have to use one resource (pure drinking water) to flush away another (fertilizer).
- organic matter is allowed to go back to the soil where it belongs, improving soil structure and nutrition.

- No need to use chemical cleaners or bleaches in the toilet.

Q. Do you make them in different sizes?

A. Our loos come in three different sizes:

1. Standard – 900mm x 1200mm deep x 2150mm high £1,395.00
2. Medium – 1200mm x 1200mm deep x 2150mm high £1,550.00
3. Disabled access for wheelchair users – 1550mm x 1550mm deep x 2150mm high - £2350.00.
4. Extra large disabled access is 1550 x 2000 x 2150. Please ask about this size.

Our disabled access loo, has two grab rails around the walls, a wider door (980mm) for easier access, a shallower threshold so that users can access the unit easily and the loo seat is at a standard loo height. Please note: our latest design comes with the toilet seat at the standard indoor toilet height. No awkward steps to manoeuvre. Easy access and easy use for disabled people and for adults with small children.

Q. Can we have a gents urinal fitted into the cubicle?

A. Yes, we can fit a waterless gents urinal into any of the sizes except and small unit.

Q. Siting the unit?

A. We advise that the unit should be sited on a concrete slab some 45cm wider to both sides and at the back, than the unit and with a solid concrete base to the front, enough to make easy access for a wheelchair if you are purchasing the extra large unit.

Terms of business – September 2018:

1. All goods are sold subject to the price as per our written quote and remain the property of Eco Loos until paid for in full.
2. All accounts are strictly pro-forma. All orders must be paid for when you order. Your order will only be processed once payment has been received as cleared funds into the nominated bank account.
3. Payments can be made via bacs payments at: Santander, Account number: 35546283, Sort code: 09-01-32 in the name of MA and IT Law. Please quote your invoice number when making payments. Cheques, to be made payable to **MA and IT Law**. We always allow 7 working days for the cheque to clear before we start building your units.
4. Delivery of goods: Our courier service is a 48hr pallet delivery, this means that the item will be delivered to you between 9am and 6pm on the arranged day. If you require your order for a specific date please advise us when ordering. We will do our best to accommodate any dates you have but cannot guarantee delivery, once the goods have left us. Your units are delivered pre-erected on a pallet. **This is a tail lift kerbside delivery**. You will need to make arrangements to move the unit from the lorry to its final position. Please bear in mind that the disabled access unit weighs approx. 135kgs, the large unit weighs 115kgs and the small unit weighs 90kgs. Please check goods carefully before signing for them.
5. Any problem must be reported to us within 24hours of receipt of the goods, and the delivery driver must be told if the item is damaged in any way. Failure to do so, renders our insurance invalid and any claims void.
6. Orders can only be accepted in writing by post or via email at irenelaw@hotmail.co.uk.
7. It is our policy to deal with all orders promptly. You will be given an estimated delivery date when placing you order, which is normally around three weeks and four weeks during our busy periods during the spring and summer, and if there is likely to be any difference in that date you will be informed as soon as possible.
8. The compost toilets are built to the standard specifications as detailed on our website, each unit being purpose made. If you have any concerns as to whether these units are suitable for your needs please discuss this with us at the point of order.
